SUMMER EMPLOYMENT – JOB DESCRIPTION

Position: **GARDENER**

Hours: 30 hrs/week

Work schedule: variable, TBD; including weekends.

Wage: \$ 16.35 / hour Employment period: May 11 to July 5, 2026

Summary:

This position requires physical strength and the ability to work outdoors in all types of weather. Duties will include planting, weeding, watering, landscaping and pruning on the Station premises. The Gardener also welcomes visitors and has reasonable knowledge about plants and the history of the Station that can be shared with the public.

Job Requirements:

- To be eligible, youth must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period, as per Canada Summer Jobs funding's stipulation.
- Must be available to work weekends and have a flexible schedule.

Job Responsibilities:

The summer gardener's tasks and responsibilities include to:

- Participate in the design, preparation, planting and maintenance of the Station Arts Centre's garden – including daily weeding and watering the garden.
- Respond to garden-related questions from the public.
- Perform small maintenance duties such as painting or staining wood.
- Assist in ensuring a positive customer experience for all Station's visitors.

The gardener will work under the guidance of and report to the SAC Director and work with Station Arts Centre's volunteers when applicable. The gardener will work at the Station's garden with supervised training in order to develop their skills with hands-on practice.
